Re: Jim Barron Varsity Track & Field Championships

We are pleased to host the Jim Barron Varsity Track & Field Championships involving your teams on Thursday, May 9th at Rux Stadium. Coaches meeting for scratches only at 3:15 PM in team room on north end of concession stand building.

Meet information:

1. Entries will be done online via Athletic.net or at tracksidetiming.com by Tuesday, May 7th at 6 PM. Meet can be found by searching “Classic 8 Conf. Championship” on athletic.net. Final entries will be posted by 9 AM Wednesday, May 8th on tracksidetiming.com.
2. Any changes after 9 AM Wednesday, May 8th must be supported by a letter from athletic director.
3. Participants are limited to a maximum of four (4) events. Schools are limited a maximum of three (3) participants per event and one (1) relay team per event. **Maximum total individual entries is 35.**
4. Coaches meeting will occur at 3:15PM in the team room on north end of concession stand building. Any athlete that is scratched **and replaced** may not compete in any meet event. Challenges to seed times from one school to another will be heard at the coaches meeting.
5. Any changes to individual entries for RELAYS require a NEW RELAY CARD which is to be presented to the Clerk at the start line. Cards will be found at the scorer’s table.
6. The shot put and discus will be conducted in flights. Each athlete will be given 3 throws in preliminaries.
7. The long jump and triple jump will be conducted by the open pit method. Each jumper will be given 3 jumps. The open pit time will be determined on number of athletes in the event. Finals will begin 15 minutes after scheduled close time of open pit.
8. Top 9 competitors from the trial flights of shot put, discus, long jump, and triple jump will move on to finals competition. Finals will be conducted in flight format.
9. The high jump starting height will be determined by WIAA standards. The bar will move up 2” until 6 competitors are left and then 1” until completion.
10. The pole vault opening height will be determined by WIAA standards. The bar will move up 6” until 6 competitors are left and then 3” until completion.
11. 15 minute check out period for running events. Athlete must check out with judge. The 15 minutes starts when athlete is called to compete.
12. Spikes: 1 / 4” Maximum
13. Team areas are outside 4’ restraining fence
14. All coaches, expect those administering an event are expected to be outside the 4’ restraining fence or flagged area (long/triple jump. **Only exception is Pole Vault coaches.**
15. Awards Scoring – Eight (8) place scoring 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1
16. Medals awarded for paces 1-3
