### **FIELD EVENTS**

**Implements:** All field event implements must be weighed and checked prior to the start of competition. All shot & discus must be checked-in at the storage garage on the south end of the track before any warm-ups are allowed. Vault poles will be checked in at the pole vault pit.

**Starting Heights:** To be determined by entries, according to WIAA regulations.

## RUNNING EVENTS

Clerk of course will be located at south end of the track. All runners will report there, with the exception of the 300 hurdles and the 200 dash which will report to their respective starts.

Timing: FAT timing will be used. Participants will be issued hip numbers to place on their uniform when they check in with the clerk of course. The hip number table will be set up on the south end of the track, near the starting line of the 100meter dash. Hip numbers **MUST** be visible and worn on **LEFT HIP**.
